1. INTRODUCTION:

- 1.1 The Mandela Bay Development Agency (MBDA), a Municipal Entity of the Nelson Mandela Bay Metropolitan Municipality (NMBMM), wishes to establish a panel of accredited professional service providers and accordingly invites suitably qualified and experienced professional service providers to apply for evaluation and listing as accredited service providers.

2. INTERPRETATION AND DEFINITIONS:

 - 2.1.1 clause headings are for convenience and are not to be used in its interpretation;
 - 2.1.2 unless the context indicates a contrary intention and expression which denotes -
 - 2.1.2.1 any gender includes the other genders;
 - 2.1.2.2 a natural person includes a juristic person and visa versa;
 - 2.1.2.3 the singular includes the plural and visa versa.
- 2.2 Unless the context clearly indicates otherwise, the following words shall have the following meanings in this Agreement –
 - 2.2.1 "Applicant" means any person or entity, who receives and/or responds to this Invitation;
 - 2.2.2 "B-BBEE status level of contributor" means the B-BBEE status of an entity in terms of a code of good practice on black economic empowerment issued in terms of Section 9(1) of the Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Act;
 - 2.2.3 "black people" has the meaning assigned to it in Section 1 of the Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Act namely Africans, Coloureds and Indians:

- 2.2.3.1 who are citizens of the Republic of South Africa by birth or decent; or
- 2.2.3.2 who became citizens of the Republic of South Africa by naturalization before 27 April 1994, or on or after 27 April 1994 and who would have been entitled to acquire citizenship by naturalization prior to that date;
- 2.2.4 "Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Act" means the Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Act, 2003 (Act No. 53 of 2003);
- 2.2.5 "EME" means an exempted micro-enterprise in terms of a code of good practice on black economic empowerment issued in terms of Section 9(1) of the Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Act and, for the purposes hereof, an enterprise with an annual Total Revenue of R10 million or less:
- 2.2.6 "in the service of the state" means to be -
 - 2.2.6.1 a member of -
 - 2.2.6.1.1 any municipal council;
 - 2.2.6.1.2 any provincial legislature; or
 - 2.2.6.1.3 the National Assembly or the National Council of Provinces.
 - 2.2.6.2 a member of the board of directors of any municipal entity;
 - 2.2.6.3 an official of any municipality or municipal entity;
 - 2.2.6.4 an employee of any national or provincial department, national or provincial public entity or constitutional institution within the meaning of the Public Finance Management Act, 1999 (Act No.1 of 1999);
 - 2.2.6.5 an executive member of the accounting authority of any national or provincial public entity; or
 - 2.2.6.6 an employee of Parliament or a provincial legislature;
- 2.2.7 "Invitation" means this Invitation;
- 2.2.8 "MBDA" means the Mandela Bay Development Agency, a municipal entity established by the NMBMM;
- 2.2.9 "NMBMM" means the Nelson Mandela Bay Metropolitan Municipality;
- 2.2.10 "proof of B-BBEE status level of contributor" means:
 - 2.2.10.1 The B-BBEE status level certificate issued by an authorised body or person; or
 - 2.2.10.2 A sworn Affidavit as prescribed in the B-BBEE Codes of Good Practice in respect of an EME or QSE.

2.2.11 "QSE" means a qualifying small business enterprise in terms of a code of good practice on black economic empowerment issued in terms of Section 9(1) of the Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Act and, for the purposes hereof, a Measured Entity with an annual Total Revenue of between R10 million and R50 million;

OBJECTIVES:

- 4.6 The MBDA reserves the right not to establish the panel of accredited professional service providers.
- 4.7 Receipt by the MBDA of the Applicant's response shall not in any manner whatsoever oblige the MBDA to enter into any negotiations or to enter into any contract with the Applicant.
- 4.8 MBDA accepts no liability for any loss incurred by any person(s) due to events or actions taken as a consequence of the preparation and dissemination of this Invitation.
- 4.9 Any costs and/or expenses incurred by any Applicant in submitting its response shall be for the exclusive account of the Applicant and the MBDA shall not be liable in this respect whatsoever.
- 4.10 The Applicant acknowledges and agrees that it shall have no claim or claims whatsoever against the MBDA and/or the NMBMM, including claims for damages whether direct, indirect or consequential, arising from and/or pursuant to and/or in relation to the submission by the Applicant of its response pursuant to the Applicant having been invited to submit same in terms of this documentation.

4.11 Any Applicant:

- 4.11.1 having a conflict of interest in respect of the transaction for which the response is submitted or in the Service of the State; and/or
- 4.11.2 having been convicted for fraud or corruption within a five year period prior to the submission of its response; and/or
- 4.11.3 who has wilfully neglected, reneged on or has failed to comply with a government or local government contract within a five year period of the submission of its response; and/or
- 4.11.4 has outstanding tax obligations to the South African Revenue Services in respect of which arrangements have not been made; and/or
- 4.11.5 is in arrear in respect of charges payable to the NMBMM in terms of Section 118 of the Municipal Systems Act and has failed to make suitable arrangements to settle such arrears;

- shall be barred from applying.
- 4.12 Professional service providers whose services are currently being utilised by the MBDA are required to comply with this notice.
- 4.13 Failure to provide all information required in this Invitation will result in the application not being considered.
- 4.14 The MBDA shall be entitled to list an Applicant as an accredited professional service provider in respect of the discipline/s applied for and to maintain such listing for as long as the Applicant complies with the pre-qualification criteria herein contained.
- 4.15 The Applicant acknowledges that this invitation for it to submit a response to the MBDA as constituted by this document, does not confer on the Applicant any legal right or entitlement or legitimate expectation in relation to the MBDA and the Applicant acknowledges that this invitation similarly does not impose or create any obligation on the MBDA to be discharged in favour of the Applicant.
- 4.16 The MBDA, notwithstanding this invitation and the appointment of any Applicants to any of the panels, reserves the right to follow a separate and complete competitive bidding process in respect of the procurement of any goods or services, notwithstanding that such goods and/or services may be supplied or available from Applicants appointed to any panel.
- 4.17 No verbal and / or telephonic queries and clarifications will be entertained by the MBDA and must be made in writing and will be responded to accordingly. The MBDA reserves the right to circulate the questions and answers to all registered Applicants in the form of a bulletin. 5. PRE-QUALIFICATION CRITERIA:

- 5.1 This Invitation is subject to pre-qualifying criteria and the condition that any Applicant must:
 - 5.1.1 Hold a level One, Two or Three B-BBEE status level of contributor; or
 - 5.1.2 Be:
 - 5.1.2.1 an EME having an Enhanced B-BBEE recognition level for an Exempted Micro-Enterprise of a Level One Contributor (an EME which is 100% owned by black people) or a Level Two Contributor (an EME which is at least 51% owned by black people);

or

5.1.2.2 a QSE having an Enhanced B-BBEE recognition level for a Qualifying Small Enterprise of a Level One Contributor (a QSE which is 100% owned by black people) or a Level Two Contributor (a QSE which is at least 51% owned by black people).

- 5.1.3 The Applicant shall have and maintain Public Liability Insurance cover for the amount of not less than R5 000 000.00 (Five Million Rand) per claim and shall make payment of all premiums payable in respect of such policy promptly on due date and furnish the MBDA with proof of such insurance and confirmation of the payment of such premiums on demand.
- 5.2 Any Applicant failing to meet the pre-qualifying criteria stipulated in 5.1 will not be accepted.
- 5.3 All Applicants are required to submit the required proof of B-BBEE status level of contributor in response to this Invitation clearly marked Annexure "B".

6. FUNCTIONALITY:

- 6.2 Any response scoring less than 35 points out of 50 per discipline/s will not be an acceptable response in respect of the discipline/s under evaluation.

- 8.20 All Applicants should furnish proof that all amounts due to the Nelson Mandela Bay Metropolitan Municipality by the Applicant, it's Directors, Members, Trustees or Partners are up to date or that arrangements have been made in respect thereof. Applicants whose address or registered office is not within the jurisdiction of the Nelson Mandela Bay Metropolitan Municipality should furnish proof that all amounts due to the local authority in whose jurisdiction their address or registered office is situated are up to date or that arrangements have been made in respect.
